- Student schedules will be mailed to families during the first week of June. Students will have an opportunity in June to request schedule changes. Changes will only be allowed if space permits. After June 4th, contact Seth Leslie at seth.leslie@mvla.net or 650-960-8822 to request a change. Freshmen will be assigned a 4 year high school counselor in August. Counselors will also be available in August before the opening of school.
- All freshmen must take PE, Survey of Composition and Literature, World Studies. 9th grade Sports are for elective credit only. Freshmen may choose one of the following math classes: Math Mastery, Algebra 1 Enhanced (double block), Algebra 9, Geometry 9, Geometry Honors, Algebra II, Algebra II Honors.
